The Putnam County Chapter of the New York State Horse Council holds two Hunter Paces during the year. This year's Spring Pace will be held on June 8<sup>th</sup>. The Fall Hunter Pace, a part of the Associated Bridle Trails Fall Series Pace, will be held on September 14<sup>th</sup>. This pace is held in conjunction with five other local horse organizations, combining scores over the six paces, resulting in Grand Champion and Reserve Champion in four divisions – Hunt, Pleasure, Western and Junior. Our paces are held at the Putnam County Park in Carmel, NY.

We maintain and create trails for our Hunter Paces at the Putnam County Park and surrounding DEC lands. We've entered into a stewardship with the DEC, promising to help take care of these trails. The pace trail system is made up of approximately seven miles of trails and about 70 jumps up to 2 ½ feet high.

We hope to do some mini-rides for club members, have several lectures or demos and enjoy our horses and other members this year.

The chapter donated this year to the NYSHC Millennium Horse Medallion Program High Point Award.
